Preview

Durham Dynamos go in search of their second win of the season as Middlesex Crusaders head north to Chester-le-Street for this Norwich Union National League Division Two clash.

Both teams come into the game off the back of defeats. The Dynamos were all out for 204 at Hampshire after reaching 95 without loss. Paul Collingwood and Jon Lewis both passed the half-century mark but Australian star Shane Warne was instrumental in the Dynamos' demise with two of the first three wickets at Basingstoke.

The Crusaders were defeated by a Derbyshire Scorpions side inspired by Dominic Cork. The former England man hit 64 runs and claimed the wicket of the Crusaders' top scorer of the day, Justin Langer, for 56.

Owais Shah will be hoping for an improved return from his trip the crease against the Dynamos after hitting just nine runs off 50 balls against Derbyshire.

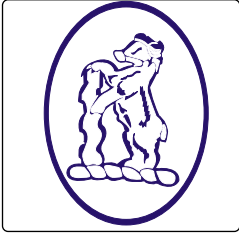

Warwickshire Bears will hope that their two star batsmen can keep up their form in the Norwich Union National League Division Two match against Essex Eagles.

Nick Knight and Trevor Penney ended the last round of matches with the highest averages in the league of 114 and 101 respectively. Knight hit 60 runs over two innings against the West Indies and was one of the few players to emerge with any credit from a disappointing England performance in the first Test.

Both sides will have very little respite before this clash, with the Eagles playing the day before against Nottinghamshire Outlaws. They will need Ashley Cowan to reproduce the form he showed at Cardiff where he claimed four wickets in a 20-run defeat against Glamorgan. Darren Robinson top-scored for the Eagles in that game with a respectable total of 51 runs.

Preview

This match will give on-song Nottinghamshire Outlaws another excellent chance to cement their place at the top of Division Two of the Norwich Union National Cricket League.

Derbyshire Scorpions' only Division Two win so far came in their last match against Middlesex Crusaders and the Scorpions will be looking to see if there is enough sting in their tail to follow this up with victory over the Outlaws.

Former England star Dominic Cork was the main architect of the Crusaders' demise, though, unusually, his match-winning contribution was with the bat. Coming in at number three, he fired 64 off 111 balls to give his side a defensible total.

They will take heart from the win over Durham Dynamos at Basingstoke which included a fine 83 not out from John Stephenson and a four-wicket haul from Alan Mullally as the visitors collapsed after a cracking start.

The Hawks face a tough trip to Glamorgan Dragons before this clash which could put the skids on their recovery.

Ian Ward and Graham Thorpe are the Lions' big hitters and both impressed in the three-wicket victory over lowly Derbyshire Scorpions. Thorpe could still feature in England's summer series against the West Indies after Nasser Hussain's men slumped in the first Test.
