

# ● FOXES' TITLE HOPES FACING TOUGH TEST

The battles at the top and bottom of the Norwich Union League First Division take centre stage as the competition moves on apace.

Joint leaders Leicestershire Foxes and Kent Spitfires clash in a battle of the heavyweights at Grace Road and at the bottom, stragglers Surrey Lions and Northamptonshire Steelbacks meet at Guildford.

The Foxes will put their 100% record on the line as they take on their closest challengers in the first of two encounters in two weeks that could determine the destiny of the title.

Vince Wells' side have been in fearsome form all season with victories in all seven of their games but the Spitfires will have no intention of relinquishing their proud unbeaten record without a fight.

# ● SHARKS AIM TO CUT DYNAMOS TO SHREDS

Durham Dynamos will have their sights set on closing the gap on leaders Worcestershire Royals at the top of the Norwich Union League Second Division as they take on Sussex Sharks at The Riverside.

The Dynamos are currently second in the table as Graeme Hick's side have a four-point lead after their win over Lancashire Lightning, but they will hope to take advantage of the Royals' inactivity in the next round of matches.

Jon Lewis' side have been in superb one-day form of late and may feel aggrieved not to be closer to the Royals after two no results.

The Sharks, however, do not lack bite and will smell the blood of an upset. In Murray Goodwin and Richard Montgomerie they have an explosive and in-form opening pair and the performances of youngsters Michael Yardy, Matt Prior and Bas Zuiderent have been one of the season's success stories.

At the opposite end of the table Essex Eagles, with half their fixtures already gone, face a battle to avoid the wooden spoon.

In the other Second Division game to take place in this round, Derbyshire Scorpions will hope to put a dent in Glamorgan Dragons' promotion hopes.

MATCH PREVIEW

The Norwich Union League First Division title race hots up as the leading contenders meet in the first of two eagerly-anticipated clashes.

Leicestershire Foxes go into the game in red-hot form after slaying Yorkshire Phoenix at Scarborough in their last outing to record their seventh straight win.

The county now also have one of the world's top one-day performers in their line-up in Shahid Afridi and Kent Spitfires know their title hopes will rest on their ability to tame the impressive Foxes.

Pakistan all-rounder Afridi has signed with the club until the end of the season after Australian Daniel Marsh was ruled out through injury. Marsh had performed impressively with bat and ball, averaging 68.88 from his five Norwich Union League innings, and his replacement will have a hard act to follow.

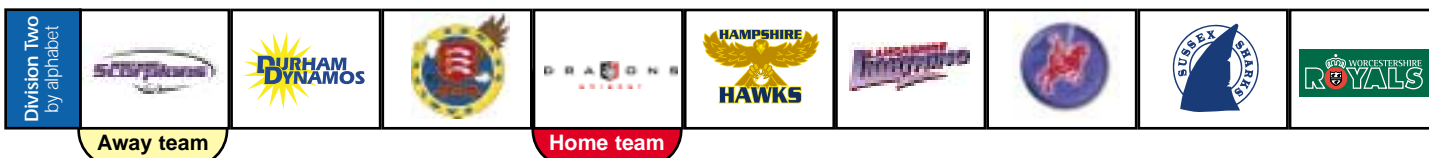

### THE DUCKWORTH/LEWIS SYSTEM

If matches are rain-affected the Duckworth Lewis system is used to reset targets. The system is based on what percentage of its resources (overs and wickets) a team have left. With 50 overs left and 10 wickets remaining, a team has 100 per cent of its resources left. The table shows the percentage of resources at other stages in the innings.

The procedure for working out targets is as follows:

1) For each innings: Use the table to calculate the resource percentage lost by the interruption and therefore calculate the resource percentage still available.

2) If team 2 have less resources available than team 1, calculate the ratio of the resources available to both teams. Team 2's revised target is obtained by scaling down team 1's score by this ratio.

3) If team 2 have more resources available than team 1, calculate the amount by which team 2's resources exceeds team 1's.

Work this out as a percentage of 225 (the average 50-over score in ECB matches and one-day internationals). This gives the extra runs to add to team score to give team 2's target.

### HOW THE NORWICH UNION LEAGUE WORKS

The Norwich Union League operates on a three-up, three-down basis with the top three finishers in Division Two replacing the bottom three in Division One. Four points are awarded for a win, while teams will take two points each if matches are tied or the weather intervenes before the required number of overs have been completed and there is no result.

Matches will start at 1pm and end at 7.10pm with 45 overs per side, although all fixtures will begin 30 minutes earlier in September. Floodlit games will start at 4.10pm. The free-hit rule for no-balls applies to front-foot no-balls only. A batsman cannot be

dismissed from the bowler's next delivery after such an infringement.

This season teams will face penalties for slow over rates. If in the opinion of the umpire there are still overs to be bowled at the cut-off point then six runs will be added to the batting team for every over left to be bowled. If at cut-off time there are still four overs left to be bowled then 24 runs will be added to the batting team's score. The batting team will then go on and finish their overs. These will appear as penalty runs on the scorecard. If this takes the batting team over the target required then the match will finish at that point.
