

# ● SPITFIRES CAN TAKE TITLE RACE DOWN TO THE WIRE

**K**ent Spitfires go into their game against Northamptonshire Steelbacks knowing a win would take the Norwich Union League title race down to a thrilling last-day conclusion.

Leicestershire Foxes looked set to claim the crown, but recent defeats at the hands of Somerset Sabres and Gloucestershire Gladiators, coupled with the wash-out against Warwickshire Bears, have given the Spitfires renewed hope.

Matthew Fleming's side are just four points behind Vince Wells' men, and would move level with the Foxes at the top of the table if they can pick up all four points against the Steelbacks.

While the Foxes have faltered, the Spitfires have been in fine form, recording thrilling victories over the Gladiators and Yorkshire Phoenix.

The Steelbacks and Surrey Lions are already certain to be playing Division Two cricket next season, and the next set of games could well decide who will join them.

Nottinghamshire Outlaws can guarantee their safety with four points from their game at Trent Bridge against the Lions.

But having fallen to defeats to the Phoenix and the Steelbacks in their last two games, Darren Bicknell will need the likes of Greg Blewett to hit form to avoid a tense last weekend.

The Phoenix appear primed for the drop, lying third from bottom and with only one match left to play.

But the incentive for a win from their tie with the Gladiators at Scarborough could not be greater.

Victory for David Byas' team would take them two points above their west country opponents and leave last year's champions needing a win from their final game of the campaign to avoid the drop.

# ● DYNAMOS READY FOR HEAD-TO-HEAD AGAINST THE ROYALS

**D**urham Dynamos and Worcestershire Royals go into their crucial clash at Chester-le-Street both knowing that a win would secure promotion to Norwich Union League Division One next season.

The match marks the second-placed Dynamos' final game of the campaign, and having looked assured of a promotion place all season, they come into the game on the back of two consecutive defeats.

Unless Jon Lewis' side can turn things around against the Royals, who themselves have not been able to win in their last four Norwich Union League encounters, then it would mean sweating it out to see if Hampshire Hawks or Sussex Sharks pip them for the final promotion place.

### THE DUCKWORTH/LEWIS SYSTEM

If matches are rain-affected the Duckworth Lewis system is used to reset targets. The system is based on what percentage of its resources (overs and wickets) a team have left. With 50 overs left and 10 wickets remaining, a team has 100 per cent of its resources left. The table shows the percentage of resources at other stages in the innings.

The procedure for working out targets is as follows:

1) For each innings: Use the table to calculate the resource percentage lost by the interruption and therefore calculate the resource percentage still available.

2) If team 2 have less resources available than team 1, calculate the ratio of the resources available to both teams. Team 2's revised target is obtained by scaling down team 1's score by this ratio.

3) If team 2 have more resources available than team 1, calculate the amount by which team 2's resources exceeds team 1's.

Work this out as a percentage of 225 (the average 50-over score in ECB matches and one-day internationals). This gives the extra runs to add to team score to give team 2's target.

### HOW THE NORWICH UNION LEAGUE WORKS

The Norwich Union League operates on a three-up, three-down basis with the top three finishers in Division Two replacing the bottom three in Division One. Four points are awarded for a win, while teams will take two points each if matches are tied or the weather intervenes before the required number of overs have been completed and there is no result.

Matches will start at 1pm and end at 7.10pm with 45 overs per side, although all fixtures will begin 30 minutes earlier in September. Floodlit games will start at 4.10pm. The free-hit rule for no-balls applies to front-foot no-balls only. A batsman cannot be

dismissed from the bowler's next delivery after such an infringement.

This season teams will face penalties for slow over rates. If in the opinion of the umpire there are still overs to be bowled at the cut-off point then six runs will be added to the batting team for every over left to be bowled. If at cut-off time there are still four overs left to be bowled then 24 runs will be added to the batting team's score. The batting team will then go on and finish their overs. These will appear as penalty runs on the scorecard. If this takes the batting team over the target required then the match will finish at that point.
