

# RUNS GALORE AT TRENT BRIDGE?

There promises to be a run-fest at Trent Bridge when Nottinghamshire Outlaws take on Gloucestershire Gladiators in the game of the day in the Norwich Union League Division One.

The two sides, who are currently separated only by run-rate in third and fourth positions, possess the two highest run-scorers in the division in the Outlaws' Usman Afzaal and the Gladiators' Kim Barnett.

With Leicestershire Foxes taking a well-earned day off, Kent Spitfires will join them on 12 points at the top of the table should they fly out from Headingley having beaten Yorkshire Phoenix.

The Spitfires managed to pick up two points in a nail-biting tie with Somerset Sabres but they may find their work cut out against the Phoenix seam attack of Ryan Sidebottom, Gavin Hamilton and Chris Silverwood. The Phoenix are looking to move up the table having dropped to sixth place.

Runs should also be on the menu at Wantage Road when the fifth-placed Warwickshire Bears take on Northamptonshire Steelbacks.

Dominic Ostler, fresh from a superb unbeaten 134 against

the Gladiators, will be looking to add to the Steelbacks' woes as they languish at the foot of the table without a single point.

Surrey Lions, seventh in Division One, are aiming to double their points tally by beating the eighth-placed Somerset Sabres at the Oval. Mark Ramprakash is the man in form after hitting 85 not out to sink the Steelbacks last week.

# DYNAMOS & SCORPIONS AIM FOR TOP SPOT

The top two sides in the Norwich Union League Division Two meet at Derby's Racecourse Ground in what promises to be a fascinating clash.

The table-topping Durham Dynamos, with overseas batsman Martin Love, take on second-placed Derbyshire Scorpions with the leadership of Division Two at stake.

The Dynamos, fresh from their excellent 24-run win over Lancashire Lightning, will do well to overcome a Scorpions side that includes the division's highest run-maker Rob Bailey and leading wicket-taker Tom Lungley.

The Worcestershire Royals, currently third in the table, travel to Horsham to take on seventh-placed Sussex Sharks.

The battle between the Sharks' opening pair of Richard Montgomerie and Murray Goodwin and the Royals' attack of Alamgir Sheriyar and Stuart Lampitt is likely to hold the key to the outcome of the game.

Fourth-placed Glamorgan Dragons could be slayed if Essex Eagles maintain the improved form they showed in beating Hampshire Hawks. In-form all-rounder Paul Grayson is likely to be the dangerman.

Meanwhile, Lancashire Lightning are desperate for a win to get them off the bottom of the league and may well fancy their chances against fifth-placed Middlesex Crusaders when the two sides meet at Old Trafford.

NORTHANTS STEELBACKS versus WARWICKSHIRE BEARS

MATCH PREVIEW

Northamptonshire Steelbacks face the daunting prospect of a rampant Dominic Ostler when they welcome Warwickshire Bears to Wantage Road in the Norwich Union League Division One.

Ostler put reigning champions Gloucestershire Gladiators to the sword with a superb unbeaten 134 in the Bears' 39-run win at Edgbaston, and he will be looking to maintain his batting blitz against the lowly Steelbacks.

The home side are rooted to the bottom of the table having failed to pick up a single point this season following defeats by the Gladiators and Surrey Lions - and they may find their work cut out against the rejuvenated Bears.

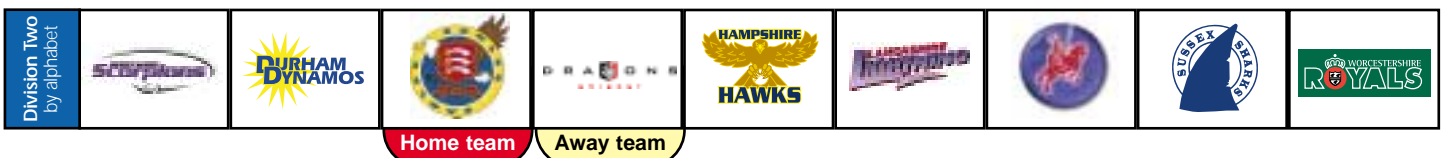

### THE DUCKWORTH/LEWIS SYSTEM

If matches are rain-affected the Duckworth Lewis system is used to reset targets. The system is based on what percentage of its resources (overs and wickets) a team have left. With 50 overs left and 10 wickets remaining, a team has 100 per cent of its resources left. The table shows the percentage of resources at other stages in the innings.

The procedure for working out targets is as follows:

1) For each innings: Use the table to calculate the resource percentage lost by the interruption and therefore calculate the resource percentage still available.

2) If team 2 have less resources available than team 1, calculate the ratio of the resources available to both teams. Team 2's revised target is obtained by scaling down team 1's score by this ratio.

3) If team 2 have more resources available than team 1, calculate the amount by which team 2's resources exceeds team 1's.

Work this out as a percentage of 225 (the average 50-over score in ECB matches and one-day internationals). This gives the extra runs to add to team score to give team 2's target.

### HOW THE NORWICH UNION LEAGUE WORKS

The Norwich Union League operates on a three-up, three-down basis with the top three finishers in Division Two replacing the bottom three in Division One. Four points are awarded for a win, while teams will take two points each if matches are tied or the weather intervenes before the required number of overs have been completed and there is no result.

Matches will start at 1pm and end at 7.10pm with 45 overs per side, although all fixtures will begin 30 minutes earlier in September. Floodlit games will start at 4.10pm. The free-hit rule for no-balls applies to front-foot no-balls only. A batsman cannot be

dismissed from the bowler's next delivery after such an infringement.

This season teams will face penalties for slow over rates. If in the opinion of the umpire there are still overs to be bowled at the cut-off point then six runs will be added to the batting team for every over left to be bowled. If at cut-off time there are still four overs left to be bowled then 24 runs will be added to the batting team's score. The batting team will then go on and finish their overs. These will appear as penalty runs on the scorecard. If this takes the batting team over the target required then the match will finish at that point.
